At this level, workers have specialised skills in community services and work autonomously under broad directions from senior management. Workers are usually providing direct support to individuals or groups of individuals.

Higher Level Skills Funding Eligibility

- · Queensland resident
- · Aged 15 years or over who is no longer at school (with the exception of VET in Schools students)
- Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- Prospective students must not have or be enrolled in a certificate IV or higher-level qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundations skills training.
- · Currently working in the community services sector

Students must complete a training and employment survey within three months of completing or discontinuing the qualification.

DELIVERY MODELS

Workplace-Based - offered in Brisbane, classroom and workplace-based (a combination of training and assessment delivery methods, including written assessment, portfolio of evidence, logbook, and practical observation including 100 hours of vocational placement), 24 months full time and 48 months part-time.

Recognition of Prior Learning - offered in Australia, externally based (a combination of assessment of written evidence, practical observation, and competency conversations), duration and fees will be determined by the quality of evidence submitted and amount of gap training required.
