EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES

After successful completion of this qualification, students may have the opportunity to progress into CHC50121-Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care

MATERIALS REQUIRED Students are required to have access to a computer with suitable word processing software and will require access to the internet for research purposes.

COURSE CREDIT Credit may be assigned for the recognition of equivalence in content and learning outcomes between different types of learning and/or qualifications.

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Students must undergo a working with children police check and have a valid blue card before undertaking work placement. For further information, please visit bluecard.qld.gov.au.

Students applying to access funded places will be required to meet the eligibility requirements applicable to the funding program, this may include undertaking a Language, Literacy and Numeracy test.

#### **DELIVERY MODELS**

Classroom Based - offered in Brisbane, classroom and workplace-based (combination of training and assessment delivery methods, including written assessment, portfolio of evidence, logbook, and practical observation including 160 hours of vocational placement), 56 weeks full time.

RPL - offered in Australia, external based (combination of assessment of written evidence, practical observation and competency conversations), duration and fees will be determined by quality of evidence submitted and amount of gap training required. #### **CAREER START**

#### **General Training Pathway - Eligibility**

To access a subsidised training place under Career Start, a student must meet the following criteria:

- · aged 15 years or older;
- not be a school student;
- · permanently reside in Queensland;
- be an Australian citizen, or Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), or a temporary resident with the right visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen;
- not already have a certificate III or higher qualification completed within the last 10 years (qualifications completed as a school student and foundation skills qualifications do not count);
- not be enrolled in another qualification, even if it is on hold or deferred, whether funded by DTET or not (foundation skills qualifications do not count).

## Apprenticeship/Traineeship Pathway

School students can only access apprenticeships and traineeships through a registered SAT. This is to ensure a school student does not use their entire apprenticeship/traineeship entitlement while at school.

## To be eligible to receive government subsidised training, the apprentice or trainee must:

- have entered into a Contract (training contract) for a qualification that is funded by DTET and be registered on DTET's training database;
- if from overseas, have a visa allowing them to work in Australia; and
- not have already completed two apprenticeship/traineeship qualifications (including SATs) within the last 10 years.

#### **General Training Pathway - Eligibility**

To access a subsidised training place under Career Boost, a student must meet the following criteria:

- aged 15 years or older;
- not be a school student;
- permanently reside in Queensland;
- be an Australian citizen, or Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), or a temporary resident with the right visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen;
- not already have a certificate IV or higher qualification (including tertiary qualification) completed within the last 10 years (qualifications completed as a school student and foundation skills qualifications do not count). Note: This eligibility requirement does not apply to individuals seeking to enrol in a skill set;
- not be enrolled in another qualification, even if it is on hold or deferred, whether funded by DTET or not (foundation skills qualifications do not count).

#### Apprenticeship/Traineeship Pathway

To be eligible to receive government subsidised training, the apprentice or trainee must:

- have entered into a Contract (training contract) for a qualification that is funded by DTET and be registered on DTET systems;
- if from overseas, have a visa allowing them to work in Australia; and
- not have already completed two apprenticeship/traineeship qualifications (including SATs) within the last 10 years.
